Landscape

This heatwave has really done some damage to our bushes and lawns. First we had little rain all spring, every month we were below "normal" and then this heat. We wanted to aerate the lawns this year to perk them up, but it was just too dry, and now we are waiting until fall, so be prepared for your lawns not to look very pretty for a few weeks, but it will green up and look so much better.

Our new landscaper is still working to get to know the intricacies of our irrigation system, so that was not helping. Trimming of the bushes in the common areas has started, but with the heat we had to stop, it was simply too hot to work after 11 am. We will have some bushes to replace that were burned by the sun. We have the water turned on at 120% of normal, so please be patient with the way it looks right now, we are working on it.

Please trim the bushes and trees in your back yard away from the outside fences, these are owned by the HOA and we need to keep them from being damaged by the plants.

Neighborhood Watch

Recently behind our Lea Terra Neighborhood entrance sign, many used and unused bottles of alcohol were found by Karla our President and reported to police.



There has also been reports of car prowlers and potential break ins. Reminders to try and keep your garage outside lights and to keep an eye out for any suspicious activity. Please let the board know of any incidents and call the police if there is an emergency

Cable Installs

We have a lot of preventable problems with cable companies damaging our irrigation and drainage lines, it is costing everyone in our neighborhood/HOA a lot of money to cover the repairs.

Please contact the HOA Board to receive approval before the cable company digs in the common areas.

Flower Beds

Please note if you have a flower bed or strip next to your driveway those plants are maintained by the HOA. If you or a guest accidentally run over this area with your car and damage any plants, you the homeowner will be responsible for the cost of the HOA replacing the damaged plants
